## Clone Trooper - Training Fatigues

**Description:** Clone Trooper, Training Fatigues

**Prefix:** TC

**Detachment:** Clone Trooper Detachment

**Context:** Episode II: Attack of the Clones.

During their early accelerated growth period, on the water world of Kamino, all Clone Troopers receive psychological training as well as basic education in military skills.

- The early first stage uniforms are colored blue.
- The advanced second stage uniforms are colored red.

This Visual Guide has been reviewed by the detachment staff and the LMO team and is certified for use as a minimum approval guideline for GMLs. GMLs are free to approve this costume type.

- Any uncertainties or questionable aspects of the submitted costume should be brought to the appropriate DL/GML peer review section of the legion forum.

## Required Costume Components

The following costume components are present and appear as described below.



Tunic  
For 501st approval:

- Dark blue or dark red, long sleeve, under tunic with open round collar.
- On the lower part of each shoulder is a training patch which resembles a black colored "il" insignia over a white shield with black outline.



Vest  
For 501st approval:

- Light blue or light red vest with a round split collar.
- On the top of each shoulder there is a stitched seam that extends from the neck opening to the arm opening.



Trousers  
For 501st approval:

- Light blue or light red trousers matching the color of the vest.

Belt  
For 501st approval:

- Black leather belt with braided drawstring.



Gaiters  
For 501st approval:

- Gaiters are made of black leather or leather like material.
- Gaiters are calf length and wrap around the lower leg.



Boots  
For 501st approval:

- Boots are made of black leather, or leather like material.
- Boots are ankle height.
